Please find attached a suggested 'kit list' for our visit to Condover Hall. The majority of our activities will be outside so please bear this in mind when packing.

Timetable for Condover Hall drop-off Monday 30th March:

Please arrive at school at the usual time to register the children in the **KS2 Hall**.

If any medication is being taken to Condover, this needs to be signed over to staff in the KS2 Hall.

We will be leaving school shortly after registration between 9:20 and 9:30 am.

We should be arriving at RAF Cosford at approximately **10:30am**.

Lunch 12:45pm (approx.)

Leave RAF Cosford at 1:30pm.

Arrive at **Condover Hall** at 2:00pm.

Wednesday 1st April

Leave **Condover Hall** at approximately 1:30pm.

Arrive at **school** at approximately 2:45pm.

We will contact you if this information changes e.g. significant delay. Please make sure you are available to pick your child up after Condover Hall to check they have all of their belongings.

Children can take a maximum of around £5 spending money in change with them to be clearly labelled as this will be collected in at Condover Hall.

Please ensure that your child has a packed lunch and disposable drink with them on Monday to eat at RAF Cosford which is separate to their kit.

KIT LIST

- Toiletries etc., (please note deodorants must be roll-on, no aerosols).
- Clothes, shoes and underwear. For many activity sessions closed-toed shoes, long-sleeved t-shirts and trousers are required (these are required for nearly all sessions, so bring plenty.) We recommend wearing old clothes for activity sessions.
 - Waterproof clothing (jacket, trousers trainers and wellies / walking boots).
 - x2 Large plastic bags for dirty clothes and dirty shoes
 - A bath towel. Girls may need an extra smaller towel to dry longer hair with.
 - Sunglasses, sun cream and hat in summer / Gloves, hat and scarf weather dependent
 - Pyjamas and slippers.
 - A named water bottle.
 - Children may bring one teddy bear or comforter but this must be packed in their bag

Please do not pack any valuable items, toys, footwear etc. as we are unable to store these. Mobile phones / cameras are not allowed.

Children must be able to carry their own bag.
