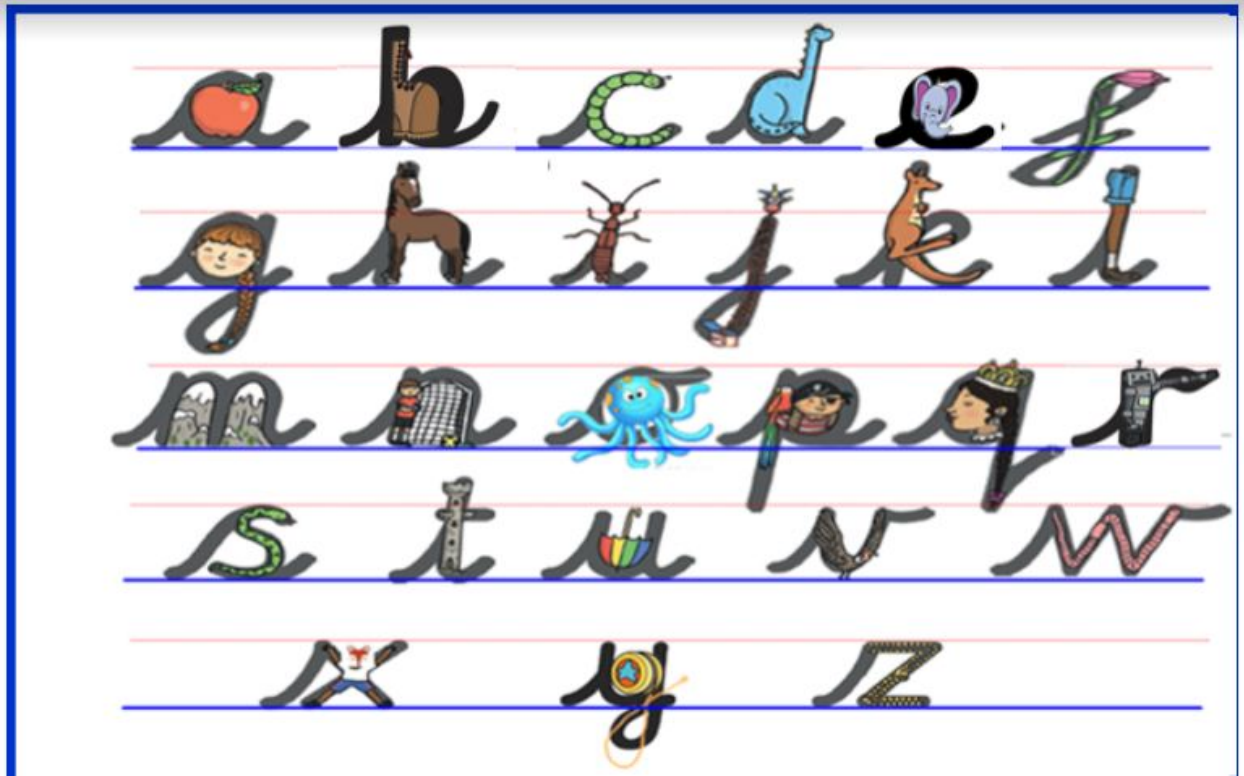


Mathematics:

- Count reliably from 1 to 20 - forwards and backwards;
- Count objects/ draw objects and say one more and one less than the given number;
- When counting children need to be able to count objects (How many pencils do I have? / I have four pencils), recognise the numeral when it is written (e.g. 3, 5); understand what 1st, 2nd and 3rd means.
